\* **Dialing Code** – The country code is +966 and the outgoing international code 00, followed by the relevant country code (e.g. 0027 for South Africa). City/area codes are in use, e.g. (0)1 for Riyadh.

\* **Time** – Local time is +3 hours GMT. Get the time in Saudi Arabia at

\* **Language** – Arabic is the official language of Saudi Arabia, but English is widely spoken. It is used in business and is a compulsory second language in schools. Among the non-Saudi population, many people speak Urdu, the official language of Pakistan, and other Asian languages such as Farsi and Turkish. Want to pick up few Arabic words before the trip? \* **Electricity** - 125 volts, 50Hz, but 215 volts, 60Hz in some (more remote) areas.

\* **Tipping** - Service charge is usually included in bills at hotels. Elsewhere a tip of 10% can be offered for services rendered. Taxi drivers can be given 10% of the fare.
